Dear Chair Parks, Vice Chair Ramirez, and Supervisors Long, Huber and LaVere:

We are writing this letter on behalf of the Latinx Bar Association (LBA) [formerly known as the Ventura County Mexican American Bar Association (VC MABA)]. LBA is an association of Ventura County attorneys and members of the public interested in justice issues in Ventura County. We are committed to the advancement of the legal profession and the empowerment of the Latinx community through education and the promotion of greater fairness and advocacy in racial equity and equal justice issues. This letter incorporates the written and oral public comments submitted by Barbara Macri-Ortiz on October 19, 2021, in connection with the Board's public hearing regarding the 2021 Supervisorial Redistricting Process (Agenda Item No. 49).

Our members have been closely monitoring the Board's redistricting process. We are pleased that the County agreed to expand its outreach to the Community, since this process had been moving very quickly. We do understand and appreciate the time constraints imposed on the Board as a result of the December 15, 2021 deadline for selecting the new maps for the five supervisorial districts.

Our members were especially pleased to see the Board reach a consensus with respect to the need to redistrict in a manner that will allow there to be two Latinx majority districts,

in light of the fact that 43.2% of the population in Ventura County is Hispanic or Latino.¹ We closely listened to the discussions at the October 19, 2021, Board meeting and in particular to the concerns raised by Board members relative to how the redistricting process may impact their individual Districts and the County as a whole. The overriding concern that was raised by several Board members was how the new maps would impact individual cities within the County. It is clear that the Board's desire is to achieve the two Latinx majority districts in a manner that limits the splitting of cities as much as possible.

We have taken your concerns seriously and believe that the Latinx Bar Association Map (LBA) that we are offering together with this correspondence in fact addresses these two primary concerns in a manner that respects the integrity of each of our cities, in keeping with the law as set forth in the Fair Maps Act and Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act. The LBA map can be accessed at https://districtr.org/plan/69298.

The LBA Map that we offer provides the following:

- 1. Eight of the ten cities in the County, including Camarillo, Moorpark, Port Hueneme, Simi Valley, Santa Paula, Fillmore, Ventura and Ojai are not divided between two or more districts.
 - 2. Two CVAP Latino majority Districts are created within the 3rd District (50.1%) and the 5th District (63.9%). The total population of these districts is on the low side but still within the acceptable range at 95.6% for District 3 and 95.65% for District 5.
 - 3. The City of Oxnard is still divided between three districts. We are residents of Oxnard so we understand the concerns raised by the City Council with respect to the redistricting process, in particular the overriding concern that the City not to be split between three Districts. Oxnard has drawn proposed

> maps accordingly. However, these maps do not allow for the County to produce two Latinx majority districts. Oxnard also indicated that it is important to consolidate the inhabited areas of Oxnard and not split Oxnard's established neighborhoods between two supervisorial districts. Finally, Oxnard would like the supervisorial district boundaries to be easily identifiable and understandable by the residents.

The LBA map attempts to address all of Oxnard's concerns in a manner that respects and addresses Oxnard's apprehensions while still allowing the County to produce two Latinx majority districts. Under the LBA map, the divisions were done in a manner that we believe is logical and fair to Oxnard, as well as to the County as a whole in the following ways:

First, no established Oxnard neighborhood has been split. We have included in District 5 as many of Oxnard's forty-seven (47) established neighborhoods, as can be accommodated in keeping with the overall goal of the County to produce two Latinx districts. The neighborhoods included within District 5 start from the furthest point north (RiverPark) and fill in the City going from North to South and east to west. District 5 would include thirty-six (36) of Oxnard's forty-seven (47) established neighborhoods.

Second, we have united Oxnard's three (3) beach community neighborhoods (Oxnard Shores, Channel Islands and Hollywood by the Sea) with the First District. Under our map, the First District would encompass the entire coastline in Ventura County. We believe that uniting the coast under one district makes sense because the biggest issue and environmental community of interest for our coastal residents is and will continue to be climate change, and specifically sea level rise. As a County, we must find a consensus on how to address this issue in a manner that makes sense for all of our residents who live along our coastline. It would not be helpful if the approach taken by the residents of one section of our coastline negatively impacted the problem in another section of the coastline. We cannot afford to play whack-a-mole when it comes to sea level rise. This is a common issue that must be approached in a coordinated and uniform manner in order to make the most progress. Additionally, we would anticipate that the

opportunities for grant funding for sea level rise projects would be enhanced if all of our coastal residents are working together on common solutions.

Third, we have united Oxnard's remaining eight (8) established neighborhoods, together with Port Hueneme and the unincorporated communities of El Rio, Nyeland Acres and Strickland, into the Third District. These eight neighborhoods in South Oxnard include Cypress, Diamond Bar, Lemonwood, Redwood, South Winds, Terrace Estates, Tierra Vista and Villa Capri. We attempted to use Bard Road and Pleasant Valley Road as natural dividers between the Fifth and Third Districts. However, we had to make some adjustments in order to balance the populations within the two districts and ensure that the Third District's CVAP Latinx population remains above 50%². The LBA Map also unites in the Third District the Santa Clara Valley communities of Santa Paula, Fillmore, Piru, and Somis, together with Moorpark and as much of the surrounding rural area as could be accommodated, while still maintaining a Latinx CVAP majority. The necessity of keeping the CVAP of this district above 50% is the reason why the Third District does not stretch all the way to the Los Angeles County line. Additionally, it should be noted that as constituted in the LBA map, many of District Three's residents share a community of interest around environmental issues related to water, including mutual water companies, well water and ground water. The County must face the problems relative to the disrepair of the infrastructure for many of our mutual water companies and also with respect to wells that are drying up. It makes sense for the County to approach this challenge in a holistic manner, together with the residents who are most impacted by these issues. Additionally, such an approach may enhance the potential of the County to compete for grant funding opportunities to address water issues.

². The two neighborhoods below Bard Road that remain as part of the Fifth District are Pleasant Valley Village, and Pleasant Valley Estates. The three neighborhoods above Bard Road that are assigned to the Third District are Diamond Bar, Lemonwood and Redwood. Two neighborhoods south of Pleasant Valley Road, Tierra Vista and Villa Capri, are assigned to the Third District, while the other neighborhood south of Pleasant Valley Road, Mar Vista, including Oxnard Pacific Mobile Estates, is assigned to the Fifth District.

- 4. District 2 unites the communities of Camarillo, Thousand Oaks and the Santa Rosa Valley. With the inclusion of Camarillo's population, District 2's population increased significantly. This increase in population necessitated changes to some of the existing boundaries of the Second District, in order to bring the population down to within the acceptable margin of 105% of the 169,078 ideal district population. At 177,220, the District population is still on the high side (104.8% of the ideal). Areas of the existing district that were moved to District 4 include Oak Park, Bell Canyon and North Ranch. Areas of the existing district that were moved to District 1 include Lake Sherwood, Westlake Village, Cal State University Channel Islands, and the Santa Monica Mountains.
- 5. District 4 includes the City of Simi Valley, as well as the unincorporated area west of Simi Valley, and the unincorporated areas east and south of Simi Valley to the Los Angeles County Line, including Santa Susana, Oak Park and Bell Canyon. The North Ranch portion of Thousand Oaks is also included in the Fourth District. At 177,413, the District 4 population is also on the high side (104.9% of the ideal).
 - 6. District 1 is the most expansive district in terms of its geography and area covered. Yet, District One's population is the closest in size to the ideal district (169,078). Its population, at 166,786 (98.6% of the ideal), makes District 1 the most balanced district in the County. It covers all of Ventura and Saticoy and everything in between to Ojai and then all the way to the Kern County line and over to the northern border of Los Angeles County. District 1 covers the entire Coastline in Ventura County, as well as the Naval Base at Pt. Mugu, Cal State University Channel Islands, Lake Sherwood, Westlake Village, the Santa Monica Mountains and the unincorporated areas south of District 2 and east of District 3.

We believe that to the extent practical, the LBA map is consistent with the published criteria that the Board will rely on in drawing district lines, including the following:

* All districts drawn in the LBA map are geographically contiguous, as can be seen on the map. District One also conforms with this requirement because there is a narrow strip of coastline along Port Hueneme that unites

the Oxnard beach community neighborhoods and Ventura with the Naval Base Ventura County and the southern section of the Ventura County Coastline.

- The LBA map also respects the geographic integrity of local neighborhoods and communities in a manner that minimizes division. Oxnard's established neighborhoods were not divided, and all of the recognized unincorporated communities were kept whole.
 - The LBA map also respects the geographic integrity of eight of the County's ten cities and minimizes the division of the cities of Oxnard and Thousand Oaks to the extent feasible. We were able to meet the Supervisors' two stated objectives: 1) keeping the cities whole, as much as possible; and 2) forming two Latinx majority districts.
- District boundary lines drawn in the LBA map are very geographically compact in the Second, Fourth and Fifth District. The First and Third Districts are much more expansive because they cover the bulk of the underpopulated rural and agricultural areas and the sparsely or unpopulated terrain in the mountainous areas of the County.
- * Most of the District boundaries follow natural or artificial barriers, either along jurisdictional borders or major roads and highways. The County staff might be able to do a better job than us in identifying and applying natural barriers between Districts One and Three in the rural or mountainous areas. However, we do caution staff to be careful in adding to or eliminating area from District 3, in that there is a very delicate balance that must be heeded in order to maintain the District at or above 50.1%.

Although not a stated criteria on the County's fact sheet posted on the web at https://www.ventura.org/redistricting/, there was considerable emphasis placed by the County's demographers on achieving districts with equal population based on the U.S. Census Data. This criteria is in fact one of the redistricting criteria established under the Fair Maps Act. We do recognize that based on where our Latinx population resides, it is impossible to meet the stated preference to have all districts completely balanced in size.

That said, all of the proposed districts under the LBA map are within the 5% deviation standard that is acceptable under the law. The populations of Districts 2 (177,413) and 4 (177,220), are within 105% of the ideal, i.e. 177,532; and the populations of Districts 3 (161,654) and 5 (161,721) are above 95% of the ideal, i.e. 160,624.

District 1's population (166,786) is 98.7% of the ideal population, i.e. 169,077.8. Thus, the Supervisors might wish to study the common boundaries between District 1 and District 2 and/or the common boundaries between District 1 and District 4 to determine whether these three districts can be balanced a little better.

We would not recommend that Districts 3 and 5 be tinkered with. Since District 5 shares no common boundary with District 2 or District 4 it is unable to incorporate any of the territory in those districts. With respect to District 3, it was extremely difficult to arrive at a CVAP Latino majority, while respecting the integrity of the established neighborhoods within the City of Oxnard and also keeping as many cities as possible whole.

We of course will make ourselves available to the County, its staff and Redistricting Partners to assist them in analyzing the LBA map. She is ready to work with staff and the public to bring this process to a successful conclusion. We would also direct staff's attention to Oxnard's Interactive Map of its established neighborhoods. The issue before you is how to complete the County's redistricting process in a manner that is lawful and beneficial, while respecting the desires of the respective cities and communities of interest. As Barbara Macri-Ortiz stated at the hearing, the issue before you is how to do that in a way that protects the rights of the Latinx minority population. We believe that one of the comments made during the deliberations was that in order to create the two Latino majority districts, the Board was going to have to pick a "favorite" child. We believe that the LBA map does in fact relieve you of that burden, since all but two of the cities have been kept whole, and the proposed division of the other two cities, Oxnard and Thousand Oaks, was done carefully and with the intent of minimizing those divisions.

We know that change is difficult for anyone and everyone. This exercise is very hard for

each of you individually and collectively, as the Board of Supervisors. However, we are confident that you will provide the necessary leadership to bring this redistricting process to a successful conclusion. The true definition of Leadership is doing what is right, even when it is hard or inconvenient, and even when it may impact your own District or your own position. We trust that every one of you on the Board of Supervisors will rise to the occasion and truly exhibit the Leadership required to complete this monumental task because your decision will have ramifications for the next ten years.

Thank you for your leadership and your courage.

While you consider the maps for revising supervisorial districts, I request you consider the following two flaws in draft map #1:

- 1. The goal of compactness is violated. Proposed districts B and E both have tendrils extending west while C has a southern hook.
- 2. The community of Oak Park is included with the city of Simi Valley in proposed district D. There is no road connection between the two that does not go through the city of Thousand Oaks. Oak Park residents shop in Thousand Oaks to a much larger extent than they do in Simi Valley. The goal of respecting a community of interest is thus violated.

On the other hand, draft map #2 does not exhibit either of these two flaws. The districts are more compact than in map #1, and Oak Park is included in the same district as Thousand Oaks.

Thus, I request that you adopt draft map #2.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Camarillo City Council voted unanimously at the City Council meeting of October 27, 2021, to take the following position on the County Supervisorial Map Redistricting process.

First, the City Council acknowledges the intent of the Board of Supervisors to establish two majority-minority supervisorial districts.

Second, the City Council strongly requests that the Board of Supervisors, to the greatest extent possible, respect the geographic integrity of the City of Camarillo and other cities in a manner which avoids or at least minimizes their division into multiple supervisorial districts; and

Dear Ventura County Supervisors,

Redistricting is a vital process to ensure fair representation, with decennial census requirements dating back to our nation's founding constitution, and laws to protect underrepresented communities marking some of the greatest achievements of the Civil Rights Movement. The majority of Ventura County's residents are Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) and fair redistricting is crucial for this diversity to be reflected in our political voice and representation. This year in particular will be a historic decision in Ventura County, due to the growing diversity of the county's population. After the 2020 Census, it is now possible to draw two majority Latino citizen voting age population (CVAP) districts for the county board of supervisors, triggering a new mandate under the federal Voting Rights Act, one of the landmark victories of the Civil Rights era.

Under Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act, if there is racially polarized voting in a jurisdiction, and if it is possible to draw a "majority-minority" district, it must be drawn, in order to allow the minority community to elect the candidate of their choice. An analysis of past election results clearly shows racially polarized voting in the 3rd district, where it is now possible to draw a district where Latino residents make up a majority of the eligible voter population, while continuing to maintain a Latino majority voter 5th district. The California Fair Maps Act reinforces this responsibility, clarifying that in an order of ranked criteria for drawing district maps, compliance with the Voting Rights Act must take priority over other factors.

However, these changes will not only result in better representation for Latino voters and other people of color. This is an opportunity to improve the compactness of our districts so that residents have closer access to their representatives, as well as keeping whole some neighborhoods that are currently divided.

CAUSE urges you to adopt the attached Community Map, drawn based on extensive stakeholder engagement with partners from throughout Ventura County to comply with the Voting Rights Act while best reflecting communities of interest known to local residents. The drafting process included 15 different community-based organizations in Ventura County representing broad interests and issues ranging from immigrant rights to education to workers' rights to environmental sustainability. The final Community Map was one of 7 draft maps considered by this stakeholder group over several meetings to reach consensus.





The Community Map's proposed 5th district would keep together the county's oldest historic Latino, immigrant, and farmworker communities like La Colonia, El Rio, Saticoy, Santa Paula, and downtown Moorpark as well as newer developments that have become home to our county's rapidly-growing Latino middle-class, such as North Oxnard. The communities in our 5th district have shared issues related to agriculture and farmworker rights and struggles shared by unincorporated and rural communities like groundwater well contamination and trucking along state highways like the 118. This is the historic heart of the citrus industry, with many communities built around old farm labor camps and packinghouses. This district would bring together the most historic sites of the farmworker movement and the heritage of the Chicano movement in Ventura County.

The Community's Map's proposed 3rd district would unite the industrial core of the coastal Oxnard Plain tied to the military and logistics industry. It includes both Naval Bases, the Port of Hueneme and its associated facilities, both airports, the new Amazon warehouse, along with heavy manufacturing like Procter and Gamble. It would connect the naval bases and industrial sections of Oxnard to the military housing and industrial areas of Camarillo. This district concentrates the county's largest employers and rapidly booming industries, but also community challenges with industrial pollution. Most of this district was built during the



postwar boom, and became increasingly racially diverse after the desegregation of housing in the Civil Rights Era. Now it is home to a predominantly immigrant population, with a higher share of first-generation immigrant families than any other part of the county. The coastal Oxnard Plain is the heart of the county's strawberry industry and was the historic home of the sugarbeet industry, and deals with unique environmental issues like saltwater intrusion into the agricultural groundwater supply and the restoration of the Ormond Beach Wetlands.

The Community Map's proposed 1st, 2nd, and 4th districts are intended to be slight variations of the existing districts adapted for population balancing with new census data and better alignment with communities of interest. The proposed 1st district continues to be based in Ventura and the Ojai Valley, with parts of Oxnard including the beach and harbor communities, golf course area, and Riverpark. These areas share coastal recreation, harbor redevelopment and environmental concerns, the heart of Ventura County's tourism and hospitality industry, and commercial shopping districts like downtown Ventura and the Collection. The proposed 2nd district continues to be based in the Conejo Valley, but is extended to Calleguas Creek, uniting areas connected through the Santa Rosa Valley and following the watershed. This district includes both universities, significant senior housing, and the county's highest concentration of college-educated professionals and knowledge economy high-tech industry, as well as conservation and open space concerns. The proposed 4th district would continue to connect Moorpark and Simi Valley, which are connected along the 118 and Metrolink corridor, as exurbs with many commuters into Los Angeles and middle-class homeowners with traditional values.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment and for your consideration and attention to community perspectives and voting rights considerations during this important redistricting process. We look forward to your deliberation. Please contact us if you have any questions or concerns.

Dear Board of Supervisors:

On behalf of the Santa Paula City Council, I am writing to provide formal input on the Council's priorities related to the ongoing Ventura County supervisorial redistricting process. The City Council had an opportunity on October 20 to review those options discussed by the Board of Supervisors on October 19, and formed consensus on the comments expressed in this letter.

Having reviewed the four most recent draft maps, and with the understanding that changes are still being made by the County's redistricting partners, including three new options, we believe it necessary to convey our thoughts on the issue, as legislation that achieves "fair and proportionate representation on countywide" boards is a key priority identified in our Legislative Platform. Additionally, we understand that this issue goes beyond lines on a map; redistricting is an equity and justice issue that, in the past, has systemically disenfranchised Santa Paula and our neighboring Santa Clara River Valley communities.

Our priorities lie in ensuring that Santa Paula and the Santa Clara River Valley, including Fillmore and Piru, remain whole and together in the final map. In each of our cities, school districts must not be cut out, and neither should major industry headquarters that play leading roles in our towns, such as Limoneira in Santa Paula and the Santa Paula Hospital. Cities of our size should not be bifurcated, and lines should not be drawn based on incumbency. We are confident the County is following the Fair Map Act guidelines, and our aim is only to emphasize the importance of those guidelines as they relate to our community.

Furthermore, we cannot overstate the importance of listening to public testimony and consistently keeping communities of interest in mind as lines are drawn. One shared characteristic between Santa Paula, Fillmore, Piru, and even regions such as Somis and North Oxnard is the huge role that agriculture plays in our economies. These communities, largely rural compared to others in the County, should be kept together in the final map because of the shared interests we have. We believe it is possible to achieve this while adhering to the Fair Map Act guidelines.

We respectfully submit this letter as formal notice of the City of Santa Paula City Council's priorities related to the County of Ventura's supervisorial redistricting process.

Honorable Board of Supervisors:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments as you go through the redistricting process following the 2020 Census. **The City of Moorpark opposes any redistricting map that splits Moorpark into separate districts**. This includes City opposition to Maps 1A, the "Community Plan," and the "LULAC MALDEF Plan" published on November 3.

Moorpark is the sixth-largest city among Ventura County's ten incorporated cities, with roughly half the population of fifth-place Camarillo. Bisecting Moorpark across two districts would further diminish and erode the ability for Moorpark residents and businesses to be represented in countywide policy development because Moorpark would represent only a very small portion of any individual Supervisor's constituency.

On September 1, before any maps were created, the City of Moorpark provided two comments to the Board of Supervisors as it engaged in its redistricting process:

Comment 1: Moorpark Should Be Entirely Located in One District. Comment 2: Moorpark Should Be Located in a Southeast-County District.

These comments were provided to demonstrate to the Board of Supervisors that Moorpark itself is a community of interest that should not be split. In support of this stipulation, the Board included the importance of not splitting cities as part of its direction to the County staff and its mapping consultant at its October 16 public hearing on redistricting. It was understood that, mathematically, larger communities would likely be split into at least two districts because they are more populous.

Three of the five maps published ahead of the Board's November 9 public hearing on redistricting split Moorpark and other cities:

In contrast, Map 2A would split only Camarillo and Oxnard. Map 66742, with a minor correction to what appears to be a minor mapping error on the western edge of Santa Paula, would also only split Camarillo and Oxnard. Both of those maps also have two majority-minority districts as previously prioritized and directed by the Board of Supervisors, and even two majority-Latino districts as measured by population and by voting age population.

Fortunately, the Board of Supervisors has for its consideration two other map proposals that achieve the Board's top priority of creating two majority-minority districts while splitting only two cities, rather than splitting four cities, into multiple districts. The City of Moorpark encourages the Board to adopt a new district map that does not split Moorpark.

Dear Chair Parks and Board:

As your Board considers redistricting options for Ventura County, the Oak Park Municipal Advisory Council (MAC) strongly recommends that our community remain in its entirety within the same Supervisorial District as the City of Thousand Oaks. Oak Park is the largest unincorporated community in Ventura County. The Oak Park MAC is an elected body that represents approximately 14,000 Oak Park residents and we work very closely and extensively with the District 2 Supervisor to meet our community's needs.

Oak Park is a community of like needs, economics, areas of interest and shared services as our adjoining neighbor, the City of Thousand Oaks. We share transportation connectivity, municipal services and infrastructure, police services, and community values.

Oak Park is situated in the Conejo Valley and is contiguous to the City of Thousand Oaks sharing a common border along Lindero Canyon Road and Kanan Road. There is an economic similarity between Oak Park and neighboring Thousand Oaks and North Ranch, and we share the same open space and tree preservation values. Students from Oak Park Unified and Conejo Valley Unified School Districts participate in events, activities, and sports together.

Our MAC was made aware of the possibility of moving Oak Park out of District 2 and into District 4 with Simi Valley. However, we feel that would not be a good fit for our community. Simi Valley is topographically distinct and geographically distant from Oak Park with no shared roads. Oak Park is a part of the greater 101 corridor community and part of the Conejo Valley that stretches from Agoura Hills through Westlake Village and Thousand Oaks to the Conejo Grade. In comparison, Simi Valley is about a half hour away from Oak Park. We share no mutual police, utility, or transportation services with Simi Valley as we do with neighboring Thousand Oaks. Oak Park residents utilize the shopping centers and restaurants available in nearby Thousand Oaks and contribute to each other's economy to a much greater extent than in Simi Valley. Additionally, the MAC oversees the budget for County Service Area (CSA) No. 4, which includes contracting with the City of Thousand Oaks Police Department for Volunteers in Policing services in Oak Park. Simi Valley maintains a separate city police force that has no jurisdiction in Oak Park.

Oak Park has enjoyed a long history of being aligned with Thousand Oaks, and the MAC has successfully been administered by the nearby District 2 Supervisor since our MAC was founded in 1975. The District 2 Supervisor office administers several MACs and is familiar with the intricacies and interests of MACs, whereas there are no MACs in District 4.

On October 28, 2021, the Oak Park MAC voted in favor of sending this recommendation to your Board respectfully asking that as you work toward drawing new Supervisorial districts for Ventura County, you allow the Oak Park community to remain with our sister jurisdiction, Thousand Oaks.

Finally, I wanted to reiterate four principles unanimously approved by the Oxnard City Council on September 30, 2021 that the City Council wishes to see incorporated into the supervisorial map that is approved by the Board of Supervisors on or before December 15, 2021:

- 1. The inhabited areas of Oxnard are consolidated into no more than two supervisorial districts.
- 2. Established neighborhoods in Oxnard are not divided into two or more supervisorial districts.
- 3. Other cities in Ventura County are not divided into more than one supervisorial district.
- 4. The new map creates supervisorial district boundaries that are easily identifiable and understandable by residents.

Dear Supervisor Long:

The Camarillo City Council acknowledges the intent of the Board of Supervisors to establish two majorityminority supervisorial districts, but we strongly encourage the Board to respect the geographic integrity of the City of Camarillo and other cities in a manner which avoids or at least minimizes their division into multiple supervisorial districts. The City has prepared two options for consideration by the Board of Supervisors; one of which keeps Camarillo intact; and another which divides Camarillo into only two districts while preserving the geographic boundaries of most of the other municipalities in Ventura County.

Attached please find a copy of the maps that the City formally submitted through the County's Redistricting website. We feel that both of these maps are legitimate options and urge the Board to review, discuss, and seriously consider them in the Supervisorial Map Redistricting Process.

Camarillo Map 1 (https://districtr.org/plan/75044)

Beginning with a map submitted to the Camarillo City Council from Barbara Macri-Ortiz, the City adjusted some of the proposed district lines to better align with the criteria of the Fair Maps Act. This option keeps Camarillo whole, creates two Majority-Minority Districts per Citizen Voting Age Population by Race (50.2% and 63.9% Hispanic), and presents a population deviation of 9.49%.

Camarillo Map 2 (https://districtr.org/plan/75063)

Beginning with the map submitted by Supervisor Long, the City adjusted some of the proposed district lines to only divide Camarillo into two districts, not three. This option divides Camarillo along Calleguas Creek and Lewis Road, creates two Majority-Minority Districts per Citizen Voting Age Population by Race (50.5% and 59.1% Hispanic), and presents a population deviation of 7.9%.

The City's desire it to remain in one Supervisorial District. However, if the Board of Supervisors does move forward with a map to divide Camarillo, we urge the Board to divide Camarillo into no more than two districts in a way that keeps our communities of interest intact to the greatest extent feasible.

Good afternoon Chair Parks, Vice Chair Ramirez and Supervisors Long, Huber and LaVere:

Attached please find correspondence from the Latinx Bar Association (formerly known as Ventura County Mexican American Bar Association), together with our proposed map of the five Ventura County Supervisorial Districts. Our map produces two Latinx CVAP majority districts (Districts 3 and 5). As is explained in detail in our correspondence, we were able to accomplish this without splitting eight of Ventura County's ten cities. The City of Oxnard still is divided between Districts 1, 3 and 5, but in a manner that we believe does justice to Oxnard, in that we were mindful to keep each of Oxnard's existing neighborhoods intact, respect the legitimate concerns of Oxnard's residents and the City Council while also taking into consideration the overarching environmental communities of interest that are shared by the neighborhoods that have been joined with District 1 or District 3.

We also joined the City of Moorpark with District 3 and the City of Camarillo with District 2. The resulting decrease in population in District 4 and the increase in population in District 2 forced us to make some adjustments around the City of Thousand Oaks and the surrounding area. We tried to be as respectful as possible in drawing these new District boundary lines, and sought to draw the lines in such a way as to keep these Districts as compact as possible.

The Latinx Map can be accessed at <u>https://districtr.org/plan/69298</u>. For your convenience I have also attached a png file which should give you a sense of what our map looks like at a glance. The original letter is being sent to the County to the attention of Ms. Gonzalez, Deputy Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

The community of Moorpark should not be divided in two as you may be contemplating in the county maps redistricting process. Moorpark must remain intact and aligned with Simi Valley as shown in Draft Plan 2 and in conformance with the following traditional redistricting principles for fair representation:

- Contiguous districts should not hop/jump
- Maintain "communities of interest"
- Follow city/county/local government lines
- Keep districts compact appearance/function

Contiguous

"Cradled by mountain ranges, Moorpark is ...**nestled in the heart of Simi Valley – the Little Simi Valley, it is called."** (The Moorpark Story Centennial Edition by Norma Gunter, 1969). From the beginning, Moorpark and Simi Valley have been identified as one contiguous area.

This fact is documented in the attached USGS topo map (Moorpark Quadrangle) created in 1951 and later 'photo inspected' in 1974. You will note the area of our Moorpark community is noted on the map as "Little Simi Valley". The only draft plan that maintains the Moorpark community of interest in a contiguous district with Simi Valley is Draft Plan 2.

Maintain "communities of interest"

Creating a second majority-minority district is laudable and I support this goal but **"while communities of interest may include race, it cannot be the predominant factor in drawing district boundaries"** (Redistricting Partners, Traditional Redistricting Principles). Overriding this consideration is the afore-mentioned principle of contiguous districts, maintaining the communities of interest as well as the redistricting principles of maintaining city government lines and keeping districts compact. Creating a second majority-minority district should not be at the expense of dividing the historical Moorpark community of interest.

Not only is Moorpark separated from the communities in Draft Plan 1 by the significant geographical barrier of Grimes Canyon, Moorpark has little in common with the communities within proposed Draft Plan 1. They have their own unique and rich history but Moorpark does not fit within that community of interest. Moorpark should be retained in the district proposed in Draft Plan 2 for at least the following Communities of Interest principles:

- Moorpark and Simi Valley historically are identified as one contiguous area
- Moorpark is located within the area known as Little Simi Valley
- Moorpark and Simi Valley historically and largely still share economic interests
- Moorpark is within the same Arroyo Simi watershed area
- Moorpark and Simi Valley are in the service area of Moorpark College
- Moorpark and Simi Valley are in the service area of Adventist Health Simi Valley Hospital
- Moorpark and Simi Valley Rotary Clubs (5) regularly collaborate on shared projects

- Moorpark and Simi Valley share portions of Happy Camp Canyon Regional Park
- Moorpark and Simi Valley, in the east county, share a political interest regarding the provision of county programs, services and resources

Follow city/local government lines

While portions of some cities have historically crossed into more than one county district, it kept communities of interest together that shared a common interest. For example, keeping the beach communities of Oxnard/Port Hueneme together and keeping the Ventura beach area distinct because of the geographical barrier of the Santa Clara River. Or recognizing that

Camarillo shares a common high school district with the 5th District. In these examples there is a logical explanation for crossing local government lines.

Dividing Moorpark in two provides neither a logical explanation nor community benefit. Draft Plan 1 only divides the Moorpark community of interest and local government.

Keep districts compact

This is one of the most obvious reasons to keep Moorpark intact. Draft Plan 1 dividing Moorpark in two does not create a compact district, in fact it represents an egregious exception to this redistricting principle. The Santa Susana Mountains, Oak Ridge and Big Mountain are significant geographical barriers separating Moorpark and Simi Valley from the Santa Clara Valley.

Thank you for your thoughtful and attentive consideration of my comments and documentation supporting your adoption of Draft Plan 2. Much of this information is taken directly from the information presented at the recently held Redistricting Community Meeting. If you have any questions, feel free to contact me at 805-208-3570.

In response to a request of maps from cities to ensure neighborhoods and communities of interest remain intact, I am attaching the maps related to Moorpark including city council districts, zoning, demographics, and below are links to our online maps.

I understand there is a desire to create minority-majority districts within the county, however the various proposed maps that divide the City of Moorpark actually divides the Latino population within our community. The Arroyo Simi or 23 freeway are typically used as boundary lines to split Moorpark but there are notable Latino neighborhoods on either side of these physical boundaries. This is one of the major reasons we recommend keeping Moorpark within one district, in addition to our common interests with east county cities, especially Simi Valley, who we collaborate often of major issues affecting our region of the county.
